



TRAINS UNLIMITED TOURS 2005 NRHS CONVENTION TRAIN UPDATE

March 10, 2005

Trains Unlimited Tours is operating a special train from Sacramento, California to the 2005 National Railway Historical Society Convention in Portland, Oregon. The planned route includes the former Western Pacific to Keddie, the BNSF Highline to Klamath Falls, and the Inside Gateway from Chemult Junction, Oregon to Wishram, Washington. The three-day trip will operate on July 2, 3 and 4, 2005 with overnight stops in Greenville and Bend.

Update from Trains Unlimited Tours: This three-day one-way special train will operate from Emeryville, California to Portland, Oregon on July 2 through 4, 2005, timed to arrive just before the start of the NRHS Convention, **Go By Train 2005**.

First, Trains Unlimited Tours has called this train a "Sure Go" operation after receiving the confirmation from Amtrak. During the last two weeks of March, Amtrak and the carriers involved will be in negotiation regarding the final routing.

Second, the prices on all remaining unsold space will be increased 25% as of March 19 because of an increase in charter costs. To secure space at the current prices, firm orders must be received no later than 5:00pm Pacific Time on March 18. Please note that space on the special train is sold directly by Trains Unlimited Tours and not by the NRHS Convention.

Third, as of March 5, some seats are still available in four of the five classes of service offered on the train. Dome car class is now sold out.
