Basic RailCamp 2005 was beginning to fill up, with the arrival of “early bird” discount tuitions during the middle of March, according to NRHS Senior Vice President and RailCamp Director R. L. Eastwood, Jr.

The 2005 session will take place July 17-23 at Steamtown National Historic Site, Scranton, PA, and is open to young adults between the ages of 14 and 18 (entering 9th grade in September, 2005 to having graduated from high school in June, 2005). Tuition for the week-long session, including lodging and meals at the University of Scranton, is \$825, with the discounted tuition offer of \$725 good only through April 1.

Scholarship assistance is available from NRHS through the Geoffrey W. Gerstung Education Fund, as well as from individual chapters of the society.

In this eighth year for RailCamp, participants will again experience many “behind-the-scenes” opportuni-

ties at Steamtown, including interpretation, steam locomotive maintenance and operation, railroad operations, shopcraft skills and a field trip to the Canadian Pacific Railway’s East Binghamton, NY facility.

The National Park Service and NRHS have been partners in the project since its inception, with strong support from the University of Scranton, a Jesuit university located near Steamtown where RailCampers are housed and fed during the week-long session. In 1999, Canadian Pacific Railway, through its-then subsidiary, Delaware & Hudson Railway, joined in an active role, enhancing the experience.
